When I am angry, do I talk about it, or do I say or do things to hurt whoever hurt me?

Do I say I'm sorry to the person I have hurt, and I forgive you to the person who has hurt me?

Do I play fair, or do I ever cheat at school, work, or games?

Have I taken something that doesn't belong to me?

Do I tell the whole truth or do I let people believe something that isn't true?
