EUCHARISTIC MUTACLES EXHIBIT



HOSTING THE EXHIBIT

The exhibition of the Eucharistic miracles includes 166 displays of the 187 Eucharistic miracles that Carlo Acutis researched before his death at the young age of 15 in 2006.

You will need a room large enough to set up all displays. You will receive easels for display purposes. About half of the displays can go on table top and the other half can go on the floor. You are encouraged to cover the tables with tablecloth to add to the environment. You might also consider decorating the tables with flowers, rosaries, etc.

Each parish is asked to use a large TV and/or projector and screen so that, upon entering the exhibition, visitors can watch a 10 to 15 minute catechetical video. The video will be provided on a USB drive by the diocese. If you have a smart TV or projector that can play a video in a loop from a USB drive, that would be perfect. We will have a limited number of projectors available for you to borrow.

You will also receive a limited number of packets for parents with young children. These packets are for families to take home after they view the exhibit. It will include coloring pages, catechetical material, and other appropriate resources.

You will receive a stack of prayer cards for distribution to those who participate. It is important that your diocesan contact person be kept apprised if you find that you are running out of prayer cards and/or family packets. These will need to be restocked before the exhibit moves on to the next location.

EACH EXHIBIT INCLUDES:

- + 166 20"x30" panels on foam board
- One retractable banner to be placed at the entrance or in the vestibule of the church to advertise the exhibit
- + 166 easels half of these will be tabletop easels and the other half will be easels on the floor
- + Approximately 8'x15' pop up display to add to your environment. Place against the wall and use sandbags to secure the base. This pop-up display is simply meant to add to your environment. There are four different displays, depending on which one is attached to your exhibit: The Last Supper, angels, prophets, scenes from the mysteries of the rosary.
- Prayer cards, brochures, family packets*

*It is important that you contact the diocese if you run low on supplies so these can be restocked before the exhibit moves to the next location.
